Loveland's cooking program, The Hearty Kitchen Academy, continued to teach both home cooking and cooking for groups of people. Throughout the year, participants cooked for 10 different groups who came through Loveland's campus.

#### The Senator Nancy C. Detert Residential Community



In late 2023, Loveland Center broke ground on Phase I of the Nancy C. Detert Residential Community. The first ever purposely built inclusive community, the project will provide 121 new residences on the 7.5 acres adjacent to Loveland's current Venice Campus. When completed, 40% of the housing will be for individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities (I/DD), 40% will be for seniors, and 20% will be workforce housing.

Phase I of the project, which includes the construction of 3 apartment buildings, was generously supported by the State of Florida, with a \$15 million appropriation, and Sarasota County, who contributed \$5 million toward the project.



We need your help to fund phase II. This phase aims to build 28 duplexes or town homes, which will provide individuals with I/DD a new found level of independence.

January 10th, 2024 saw the first meeting of the Transitional Services cohort in North Port. This program, funded by the Wilson-Wood foundation, supports individuals who do not have waiver funding to receive supported living and supported employment services.



Loveland Creates, launched in May of 2023, continues to expand with the grand opening of the Loveland Store and online sales slated for this year.



The Love Learning Academy, launched in spring 2023, is expanding to include Therapeutic Alternatives in Crisis Training (TACT).



Recreational services offered in Venice are set to expand this year with the hiring of a Social and Athletic Club Manager.

I am also grateful to our World-class Board of Directors. Throughout this year their judgment and expert perspectives have been a huge benefit to our agency and to our participants.
