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

MISSION

To help individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities live their lives to the fullest.

VISION

A world where all people are recognized as equals at home and in their community.

our SERVICES

Loveland Center serves children and adults with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (I/DD), which are defined by Florida's Agency for Persons with Disabilities (APD) as individuals diagnosed with any one or more of the following:

- Autism
- Cerebral Palsy
- Down Syndrome
- Intellectual Disability (IQ of 70 or below)
- Phelan-McDermid Syndrome
- Prader-Willi Syndrome
- Spina Bifida

our PROGRAMS

ADULT DAY TRAINING (ADT)

Strengthen key life skills such as daily living, communication, social, and independent living skills to help meet individual goals.



SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT

Navigate the employment process with support from job coaches through the hiring and interview process to securing and maintaining employment.

SUPPORTED VOLUNTEER

Connect with your community through volunteer experiences in order to gain necessary employment-related skills.



SUPPORTED LIVING

Encourage independent living with services that support budgeting, shopping, managing household repairs, and more.

PERSONAL SUPPORTS

Provide some medical services, in addition to personal hygiene, house cleaning, and transportation assistance.



COMPANION SERVICES

Offer community-based support through recreational activities and community integration.

TRANSPORTATION

Provide transportation to and from your ADT program.



THEATRE PROGRAM

Create and explore the creative and performing arts to improve communication, social and advocacy skills.

CULINARY TRAINING

Equip individuals with kitchen safety and basic culinary skills, while promoting healthy eating habits and nutrition to live a better, healthier life.



THERAPY SERVICES

Receive occupational, physical, or speech therapy.

RESIDENTIAL

Provide you with opportunities to live independently in apartments or in a group home.



RESPIRE SERVICES

Develop key life skills, while encouraging your caregivers to take a necessary break.

• AFTER-SCHOOL CARE

Encourage academic and personal growth in a fun and supported environment.

• SUMMER CAMP

Experience an inclusive summer camp opportunity and receive support from Loveland staff, as well as weekly therapy services.

• RECREATION

Explore your community and socialize with peers in scheduled recreation opportunities. Programming available for children and adults.

• WEEKEND OVERNIGHT RESPIRE

Spend the weekend learning life skills and having fun while your caregivers take a break.
