



GREATEST NEEDS

You can make a difference in the lives of individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

NON-FUNDED PROGRAMS

Hearty Kitchen Academy \$25,000

Develops kitchen, food safety, nutrition, and culinary-industry skills in a commercial kitchen.

HKA milestones include:

- Launched Loveland Cafe;
- Improved communication and social etiquette skills;
- Strengthened listening and leadership skills;
- 25% gained employment from skills learned.

Scholarships \$70,000

Funds those unable to afford access to life skills development programs. Loveland Center commits 10% annually.

Scholarship milestones include:

- Last year, 55 participants were awarded scholarships;
- "This scholarship was a lifeline for my family. I can now work while my son is learning and making friends."

Therapy Services \$25,000

Grants speech, physical occupational, and music therapies to participants in need of services, but unable to afford access.

Therapy services will:

- Provide comprehensive evaluations in various therapies
- Develop communication, basic sensory awareness and critical motor skills.

NEW PROGRAMS

STAGE Program \$45,000

Provides a creative multi-disciplined performing arts program that culminates in a full-scale musical annually for each Loveland region.

Skills to develop will include articulation, relationship building, reading & listening comprehension, self-expression, and spacial awareness.

HERO Respite (Helping Everyone Realize Opportunities)

Kids After-School \$25,000

Builds critical life skills, creates new friendships, and offers homework assistance in a supported setting with dinner and snacks. Weekdays from 3:00 - 7:00 p.m.

Kids Summer Camp \$30,000

Allows kids an inclusive chance at the Boys and Girls Club to explore creativity, develop independence skills, and provides speech, occupational, and music therapy. Weekdays from 7:00 - 7:00 p.m.

Adult Recreation \$20,000

Weekly schedule built around community-based events that explore the community in which they live. Activities include sporting events, festivals, and area attractions.

HERO Respite

Kids Recreation \$20,000

Explore community at events and area attractions, engage in sports and recreation activities, and develop key life skills such as street safety and emergency response skills. Saturdays from 10:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

Adult Overnight \$55,000

Provides 48-hours of continuous respite care for families of adults with I/DD, while building daily living and independence skills. Friday through Sundays.

CAPITAL NEEDS

VENICE

Room Conversion 1 \$15,000

Converts an existing program room into a culinary focused life-skills program space.

Room Conversion 2 \$10,000

Repurposes a large space into smaller program rooms for continued safety.

Building Upgrades \$10,000

Repairs and/or replaces roofs, air condition units, and emergency generators.

NORTH PORT

Facility \$25,000

Operates a 4,000 square foot facility annually.

PORT CHARLOTTE

Facility \$40,000

Operates a 4,000 square foot facility annually.

BRADENTON

Facility \$50,000

Operates a 4,000 square foot facility annually.

TRANSPORTATION

Vehicles \$15,000 - 60,000

Satisfies the growing demand in transportation service requests, while also upholding Loveland's vision of community inclusion for all participants. Loveland operates a fleet of more than a dozen vehicles of all passenger capacities including sedans, minivans, large capacity vans, and wheelchair accessible vehicles.

- Since COVID-19, Loveland saw a 250% increase in transportation requests;
- One-quarter of its existing fleet will need to be upgraded to newer models within the next three years.
